Saturday March 29, 2008

Area Chair Jim C called the assembly to order and opened with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. Nicole S, Stephenville Group GSR, read "Why Do We Need a Conference."

Mock Conference Committees: Delegate Bill N reviewed the final 2008 Conference agenda and explained the organization and break-out room locations for the mock Conference committees. The Assembly then broke into mock committees to form recommendations to the Delegate on their respective agenda items. After the lunch break, the Delegate moderated report presentations from each mock committee and a Q&A session followed. Committee recorders were asked to send their notes to the Delegate for use as a reference.

Officer and Service Committee Reports not shown in the main body of these minutes are included in a 2-page addendum to the minutes as combined Assembly and Area Committee reports.

Sharing Sessions: the Assembly broke into a GSR and a DCM sharing session each of which received overview presentations from various Service Committee Chairs.

Concepts Presentation: after the dinner break, presentations were given for Concepts 1-6. A Q&A session followed.

Sunday March 30, 2008 Business Meeting

Area Chair Jim C called the meeting to order and opened with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. Dwayne B, Combined District 6 Treatment Facilities Chair, read "Why Do We Need a Conference?"

Alternate Secretary Richard R announced the upcoming mail-out schedule as May 10 at the Arlington Central Group, 1:30PM; 781 Station Dr, Arlington, phone 817-277-0962. The summer mail-out will be held at the Rowlett Group on a date in August to be determined. The Fall mail-out will be at the Frisco Group.

Secretary's Report and Minutes - Arthur S asked DCMs to submit in Group and GSR information changes for updating the GSO data base prior to printing the national AA directories. The minutes of the Winter Assembly were read and accepted. Concern was expressed that the name of the submitter of a motion is shown in the minutes. It was explained that this was done to know who to contact and who will present the motion at the Assembly Business meeting.

Treasurer's Report and 2007 Budget Review - PJ H-R reviewed reports on the (1) January - February 2008 Financial Statement, (2) 2008 Budget Paid to Date vs Actual Expenses and (3) calendar year 2007 Budget Paid to Date Reconciliation. The beginning Operating Account balance was \$14,679.22 with contributions of \$6,884.48, budget items paid of \$10,147.52 for an ending balance of \$11,416.18. The Prudent Reserve Account beginning balance was \$10,234.35 with interest of \$2.83 for an ending balance of \$10,237.18. The total area treasury balance was \$21,653.36.

Alternate Convention Chair - Cody K announced that internet problems prevented distribution of a report. A report will be sent to the Secretary later. The registration count was 169 with 110 coffee stars. Upcoming assemblies are: (1) Summer, June 21-22, 2008 at the Diane Heaven Community Center, 400 Schroeder Dr, Waco 76710. (3) Winter - January 10-11, 2009 at the Tanglewood Resort, 290 Tanglewood Cir, Pottsboro 75076 (near Sherman) \$65/night double occupancy (December 27 cutoff for reservations) phone 1-800-833-6569 (web page is tanglewoodresorts.com).

Alternate Area Chair - Jana A reported that many workshops are scheduled and there are about a dozen to be scheduled. A workshop schedule report is posted on the NETA65.org web site and calendar.

Alternate Delegate - Jimmy D reported that GSO sent a PDF document for answers to the Ask-it Basket questions from the Regional Forum in Denver. Attendees who have not received a copy can contact Jimmy. The Texas State Convention is at Odessa, June 13-15. SWAARSA 2008 will be in St Louis, MO, October 10-12. Area 38 needs to know if Spanish language members will be attending to plan for translation services. Seed money for SWAARSA has been increased from \$1,500 to \$2,500. Service Committee Chairs will be invited to set up tables at the North Texas Roundup from August 22-24. Tables will also be set up at the Gathering of Eagles event over the Memorial Day weekend May 23-25.

Old Business

9/30/2007 motion, amended 2/10/2008, submitted by Area Delegate Bill N on the question to change the last sentence of Policies & Procedures (P&P) sections 3.5, 3.6, 3.7 and 3.8 was tabled.

Secretary's Note:

There was confusion and errors on the wording of this motion due to a Secretary's transcription error that goes back to the Fall 2007 Area Committee meeting. The error was discovered after the Spring Assembly adjourned and was reported at the Spring Area Committee meeting. A corrected and amended motion was placed on the Old Business Agenda of the Summer Assembly.

9/30/2007 amended motion submitted by Area Delegate Bill N on the question to change P&P section 4.9 as follows to become effective 2009:

"The Northeast Texas Area Fall Assembly and Convention shall pay for the transportation, lodging, meals and registration for the following persons:

- A. All speakers (AA, Al-Anon, and Alateen)
- B. Northeast Texas Area Delegate
- C. Al-Anon Chairperson
- D. Convention Chairperson
- E. Northeast Texas Area Chairperson

Change to read

- A. All speakers (AA, Al-Anon, and Alateen)
- B. Al-Anon Chairperson
- C. Voice of the Convention

Outcome: the Chair asked for disapproval. None being voiced, the motion passed by unanimous consent effective as of 2009.

New Business

2/10/2008 amended motion submitted by District 61 DCM Jan L, in behalf of a District 61 member, seeking endorsement by the Northeast Texas Area to request that the Delegate submit a letter to the Trustee's Literature Committee to return paragraph #3, as it appears in the 3rd edition, 73rd printing of the Big Book, pg. 546, in the story "Freedom from Bondage."

The missing passage is: "I looked around me at people who seemed happy and tried to analyze their happiness, and it seemed to me that without exception these people had something or somebody they loved very much. I didn't have the courage to love; I was not even sure I had the capacity. Fear of rejection and its ensuing pain were not to be risked, and I turned away from myself once more for the answer, this time to the drinks I had always refused before, and in alcohol I found a false courage."

Outcome: the Chair asked for disapproval. None being voiced, the motion passed by unanimous consent.

Following the Delegate send-off, the assembly concluded with the reciting of "The Lord's Prayer."

Northeast Texas Area 65 (NETA) -Spring Committee Meeting - April 13, 2008

Hosted by the ODAAT Group of District 54, 2109 W Parker Rd #728, Plano, TX 75023

Area Chair Jim C called the meeting to order and opened with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. Seth P, ODAAT Group GSR read "Why Do We Need a Conference." Randy D made an announcement about the North Texas Roundup in August.

[Amended] Secretary Arthur S reported that the deadline for submitting changes to GSO for the national AA directories is now May 30. Minutes of the Winter Area Committee meeting were not accepted as read. The Alternate Delegate, Treasurer, Alternate Chair, Corrections Chair and a past Delegate disagreed with the wording in a paragraph noted as "Miscellaneous." The Treasurer asked that her response to questions posed on the matter be recorded. The committee approved the action of amending the minutes to address the Treasurer's concerns.

Officer and Service Committee Reports not shown in the main body of the minutes are included in a 2-page addendum to the minutes as combined Assembly and Area Committee reports.

Treasurer PJ H: distributed a March 2008 report which included a Financial Statement, Contributions to NETA and Budget Items Paid. The beginning Operating Account balance was \$14,679.22 with contributions of \$2,853.51, budget items paid of \$7,679.99 for an ending balance of \$6,592.70. The Prudent Reserve Account beginning balance was \$10,237.18 with interest of \$1.30 for an ending balance of \$10,238.48. The total area treasury balance was \$16,831.18.

PJ noted that a contribution of \$532.02 was received from the Texas State Convention. The Secretary asked if a bulk mailing could be made to the groups regarding area finances. The Delegate and Treasurer will collaborate on putting a letter together.

Alternate Convention Chair Cody K reported that the Spring Assembly had 169 registrations and 110 coffee stars sold. The room count was 81 nights and didn't meet a tier of 90 room nights. Incoming funds were \$700 from the Treasurer plus \$1,468 in coffee sales for a total of \$2,168. Expenses were \$2,709.16. The ending Convention account balance was \$415.42 (an approximate \$250 shortfall). The Treasurer requested that a Fall Convention and Assembly flyer be distributed at the Summer Assembly for preregistration. The Secretary requested a copy of a Convention finance report and assembly schedule and also requested that an email notice be sent out 6-7 weeks prior to an assembly reminding trusted servants to make hotel room reservations. The Area Committee approved a \$700 advance for the Fall Convention and (Election) Assembly.

(3) Winter - January 10-11, 2009 at the Tanglewood Resort, 290 Tanglewood Cir, Pottsboro 75076 (near Sherman) \$65/night double occupancy (December 27 cutoff for reservations) phone 1-800-833-6569 (tanglewoodresorts.com).

Ad Hoc Committees:

As a follow-on project to the District Mapping committee, Arthur S reported on efforts to create 8 ½ x 11 district and area maps. Sample maps will be sent to Area Committee members by email for review and comments. Large visuals will also be shown at the Summer Assembly. In producing the 8 ½ x 11 maps, it would be desirable, for display purposes only, to illustrate District boundaries using county lines. Urban Districts (i.e. the 50 and 60 series) would be defined by a combination of county lines and major roads and highways. The Chair emphasized that the maps do not move any groups to any other districts or anything like that - it does not involve any redistricting.

The Chair read a report on the purpose, background, scope and members of the "Ad Hoc Committee to Update the Area Handbook". Jana A, the ad hoc committee chair, conducted a page-by-page review of work to date on the handbook. Also a list of recommendations compiled by the ad hoc committee was discussed. Handbook reviewers are encouraged to send in comments and recommendations on the document. The Secretary requested that a Word document copy of the original and current draft handbook be placed on the NETA65.org web site to allow for them to be downloaded and compared side by side. The Chair noted that a more detailed handbook review will occur at the next area committee meeting.

Structure Committee past Delegate - Glenice S: reported that the motion regarding Past Delegates practicing the principal of rotation will be withdrawn. Four other motions received a Structure Committee recommendation of "no action be taken." Discussions ensued to explain how the recommendation should be interpreted and to get Structure Committee feedback on each of the motions reviewed.

The Chair called for the submitters of the motions to state how they wished to proceed:

1. The motion on Past Delegate rotation was withdrawn;
2. The motion to "Establish a position of Area Archivist and Historian" was modified to remove any reference to Registrar duties from the background information and have the position focus on digital records preservation and creation of an area history."
3. The motion to have Policies & Procedures changes require a 3/4 majority of the Assembly for approval was withdrawn.
4. The motion for 1-day assemblies was withdrawn with a request that an ad hoc committee be formed to study the matter and make recommendations. The Chair read a proposed charter defining the purpose, background, scope and members for an "Ad Hoc Committee to Investigate the Assembly Structure." The Area Committee approved the ad hoc committee formation.
5. The motion to retire the position of Audio-Visual Chair was amended to read "Retire the Area service position of Audio-Visual Chair, the coordination of the duties and responsibilities of this position to be assumed by the Literature/Intergroup Liaison.

Old Business

9/30/2007 corrected/amended motion, tabled at the Spring Assembly, submitted by Bill N, Area Delegate on the question to change sections 3.5, 3.6, 3.7 and 3.8 of the Policies and Procedures as follows):

1. The last sentences of sections 3.5 and 3.6 currently read "If the expense amount does not exceed the amount of the advance then the amount of the excess funds disbursed are to be returned to the NETA Treasury."

Change the last sentence of section 3.5 to read "If the expense amount does not exceed the amount of the advance then the amount of the excess funds disbursed are to be returned to the NETA Treasury at the end of each panel (i.e. two-year term of office)."

Change the last sentence of section 3.6 to read "If the expense amount does not exceed the amount of the advance then the amount of the excess funds disbursed are to be returned to the NETA Treasury at the end of each panel."

2. The last sentences of sections 3.7 and 3.8 currently read "If advanced funds for the year have exceeded receipts submitted for expenses then the amount of the excess funds disbursed are to be returned to the NETA Treasury at the end of each year.

Change the last sentence of sections 3.7 and 3.8 to read "If advanced funds for the panel have exceeded receipts submitted for expenses then the amount of the excess funds disbursed are to be returned to the NETA Treasury at the end of each panel."

9/30/2007 amended motion submitted by Area Secretary Arthur S to establish an Area Archivist and Historian service position.

2/10/2008 amended motion submitted by Alternate Delegate Jimmy D to Retire the Area service position of Audio-Visual Chair, the coordination of the duties and responsibilities of this position to be assumed by the Literature/Intergroup Liaison.

New Business

Administrative: discussion ensued regarding the NETA contact for the 2009 SW Regional Forum. The matter will be discussed again at the next Area Committee meeting.

- The agenda for the Summer Assembly was amended and approved.
- The Fall Area Committee meeting will be October 19, 1:30PM, at the McKinney Fellowship Group.
- The Area Inventory will be held at the Meadowbrook Group on November 9 starting at 10AM.

Nominations: Public Information Chair Jane G submitted the nomination of Lisa Mc as Alternate PI Chair. After presenting her service experience, Lisa was welcomed into Area Committee service with no disapproval.

Motion submitted by Grapevine/La Vina Chair Linda A to approve a line item increase to the Grapevine/La Vina budget for the Grape-a-thon, American Sign Language (ASL) interpreter for the key speaker and/or other workshop costs, be added in the amount of \$350. Any unexpended funds will be returned to the Treasurer. Outcome: placed on the Summer Assembly agenda as new business.

The Chair called for a motion and second to adjourn. The meeting concluded with the reciting of "The Lord's Prayer."

We will maintain a database of this for the area as well as provide requested information to GSO. This survey is bilingual. We are currently working on producing a Spanish edition of the Workbook.
