We printed four editions of the NETA Quarterly Newsletter in 2021 and three editions in 2022. My final Panel 71 Winter UpWord Newsletter has a closing date of December 8, 2022. ### **Corrections Workshop**


The Technology Chair will be providing tech support for the Corrections Workshop in October.
