ACCESSIBILITIES STANDING COMMITTEE Summer Assembly Report June 25, 2023

- Lore L. Accessibilities Chair apologizes that she is not at the Summer Assembly. The past quarter has been very busy with Committee meetings and activities.
- Virtual Zoom meetings have been held on the first Saturday of every month at 12:00pm.
- We have been adding additional different kinds of difficulties in Accessibilities to our list of issues to address.
 - o Review of Accessibilities list blind, physically challenged or disabled, wheelchair bound, walking impaired, non-driving, remote locations, languages, religions, spiritual alcoholics with babies, single parents, care givers, seniors in nursing homes, patients in hospitals, hearing impaired, autism affected, and emotional disorders. The fastest growing types of alcoholics are the seniors, infirmed, and the Hispanic population in Texas.
 - o Alcoholics not reached by traditional outreach: shut ins, single parents, caregivers, and physically remote locations.
 - o The American Disabilities Act (ADA) is a US Federal program an applies to all public buildings. Privately owned buildings do not need to comply and it is up to the building owner. Recognizing the push backs from groups with alcoholics attending meetings with dogs. Other members being afraid of the dogs. Problems including persons with allergies to animals. Not being able to ask if the animal is a service animal or not. Tradition 1 is impacted by ADA. Emotional support animals are not the same as service animals.
- Addressing low-cost solutions for groups and districts. Including reaching alcoholics in need with a single page standardized flyer. This is for two purposes: (1) The goal is to provide access to information, getting information to people who are helping alcoholics, and (2) to get the information to remote alcoholics in need of meetings.
 - o Flyers to go to police stations, hospitals, senior centers, retirement homes, and nursing homes/rehab centers as these alcoholics are not being reached by the Treatment Center Standing Committee.
 - o Offering the Accessibilities Zoom Account on an hourly basis to any District or Group wishing to hold an Accessibilities Meeting. Set up a Calandly account and distributed the information through the NETA 65 Secretary and the Intergroup offices.
 - o Collecting Big Books in other languages for groups in districts where there are populations of alcoholics from other backgrounds. Example: mid-cities area has several different Asian and Indian languages.
 - o Looking into low-cost or free access of the American Sign Language (ASL) Big Book videos for the hearing impaired alcoholics.
 - o Educating groups and districts so that all Zoom meetings for NETA 65 may close captioning to permit hearing impaired alcoholics to participate in the meetings.

- Plans are being developed for a fall workshop defining different kinds of accessibility issues, problems, and solutions.
 - Working to educate AA members in NETA 65 on the diverse types of accessibilities issues and practice humility by welcoming all persons wishing to stop drinking of all faiths.
 - Will offer panels of alcoholics with diverse accessibilities issues and the different solutions available. Addressing solutions for groups that alcoholics with accessibilities issues want.
 - o Examples: (1) A blind AA member to discuss the difficulties and the solutions (2) Discussion to go from specific to general approach. Such as remote, blind, and disabled could all benefit from the solution of a ZOOM AA meeting.
- Recognized the disconnect between the accessibilities information on the Fort Worth Central Office Data Base Meeting Guide and the AA Meeting App. Contacting all of the groups listed with Fort Worth Central Office whose groups are identified as wheelchair friendly.
 - o The project has started with Tarrant County and will then expand to other counties and districts across NETA 65. To further identify if this includes access to the bathrooms. Also to work with all DCMs and GSRs to contact the remaining groups to update their information in the database.
- Attended Tarrant CountyWide on 6/3 and set up display rack of AA Accessibilities flyers.
- Lore still looking for an Alternate Chair for Accessibilities
- Next Meeting date changed to July 8th at 12pm.
