- Lore L, Accessibilities Chair called the meeting to order at 12:01 pm. The meeting started with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.
- In attendance Lore, Tammy, Renee, Brad, John K., Luis, Mary, Evelyn; John Y., Deb S.
- In June we had only 3 in attendance - but it was a great meeting anyway: Lore, Renee, Luis
 - We reviewed accessibilities issues and solutions
 - Discussed how to address common solutions for groups and how to best present to districts for sharing
- Our meeting is now close captioned and possible in both English and Spanish or any other language. Using the NETA 65 business account set aside for the Accessibilities Standing Committee. Attendees may download a partial or complete transcript of the meetings, even if we do not record the meetings. Our workshop however will be recorded.
- New accessibilities committee member - J Scott from Dallas Intergroup Accessibilities - unfortunately not able to attend today. Plans to attend D21 meeting. Note corrected time to 2pm.
 - J Scott M. 214-244-9532 accessibility@aadallas.org
- John K read Lore's report at the Summer Assembly. There was 1 question. Are we considering mental health as part of our accessibilities issues. The answer was yes.
 - Lore received 1 question via email about ASL - regarding why hearing need ASL video - why not just read the Big Book - answer, perhaps they cannot read
 - Renee stated that hearing impaired can learn to read but the grammar is different. It is like a different language. I was born deaf. ASL and ESL (English Sign Language) are not the same. ESL educates on the actual words and language.

ASL works on concepts expressed with adjectives. More like Spanish in reverse order to describe things. There are some grammatical similarities with Spanish and French.
- Luis - Gift Group in Irving. Called GSO about labeling the Big Books at the 7AM Gift Group. They have 25 Big Books in different languages and were able to label them in get them in order. Contacting the GSO desk helped and made it possible to identify them and get them in order. Tammy also helped and attended the Gift Group. She will make a presentation to the group and write an article to send to the Grapevine.
- FTW Survey? John K. The biggest hurdle has been who to talk to that the meeting guide to talk to - the filter function - wheelchair accessible and wheelchair accessible bathroom - the bottle neck - reaching our to groups. The GSO check list. Are you accessible - do you want to be filter-able?
 - John K. - Our home group Get in the Car Group GITC we are low hanging fruit. We are wheelchair accessible in the doors and bathrooms. Other groups such as CCD and the Koppel groups are also updated. Working on the list of D61.



- Brad - how did you find the meeting app for Dallas?
- John K - I asked the FTW office manager (Erin) about what I wanted - she got me in contact with the website guy. I believe he is in a service position. He was able to assist me.
- John K - I think that Dallas is further ahead with their meeting web app.
- Luis - the Dallas meeting app is embedded in their website which works better
- Renee - D21 - Presentation **July 9 2pm - Zoom Meeting ID: 894-4169-5467 Passcode: district21**
 - Renee - Explanation of Special Needs and defining committee and function. Monthly meeting to be on the 3rd Saturday of every month - Zoom Share to start July 15
 - Lore - how many groups in D21? Renee: Thinks 25 groups with 2 groups offer ASL
 - Renee - Triad Group said 4 are inactive - need to correct listings
 - Lore - what about Spanish Groups? District 89/90? Renee: 6 Spanish speaking groups
 - Mary - Accessibilities has grown - not able to get out of their home - growing population. What is the percentage of meetings?
 - Renee - Dallas data shows that 18% of meetings provide hybrid or accessibilities
 - Renee - It is important that we show that our roll and function as a liaison to the GSRs is to find out if we doing a good job and what are some of the groups' barriers
- Evelyn - ADA Activities? - flyers appear to be sufficient - need to remind them - that emotional support dogs - about the allergies -
 - Evelyn - Working on child friendly meeting for single friendly safe and district and talk about the app and the FTW and the filter - only 6 meetings say child friendly - not a comfortable meeting. Access to things to keep kids busy such as books, blocks, noise canceling headphones for the older kids, not to hear things they should not. Chalk board paint, etc. Young moms in group to be able to go to meetings is important.
 - Lore has 2 white boards to donate to Evelyn
- Flyers for Districts - no updated activity
- Lore said that need to provide code on Calendly as the Zoom Share response time is not fast enough. D21 will be using the Zoom account and there was one other request from Jenny L. We have permission from the NETA 65 Technology Chair to use for any Accessibilities meetings.
- Discussion on dates and locations for Workshop in the Fall -- Bring back ideas for August 5
 - Evelyn - prefer to use groups - keep cost down
 - John K. - make sure that the space is accessible as well
- Lore? Any other topics to discuss?
 - John Y - Wi-Fi trying to get the cost down around the group - talk about getting rid of wi-fi it is a form of accessibility. Personal entertainment - connected to their old land line - their group does not have any hybrid meetings

Convention Report

The summer assembly was a success. Thanks again to Districts 41,42, 1, and 86 for the wonderful hospitality. I received an email that stated that the Summer Assembly was the best they attended in our area and that the host committees did a bang up job. The final cost of the Summer Assembly was approximately \$802.40.

Fall Assembly will be held at the Renaissance Dallas Richardson Hotel, September 15 - 17th. Hotel block rate is \$109.00. You may start booking your rooms now. Cut off date is Friday, Sep 1, 2023. Link will be sent out in the Notes & Notables. I did notice that we don't have the ability to choose room preference, king or double. I am working on getting this resolved. Hospitality for this assembly will be in a hotel room, likely on the 2nd floor. Coffee can be purchased at \$50 a gallon, a gallon serves 16 cups of coffee. We could set our max cost 15 gallons and reassess on Saturday afternoon, based on coffee card purchases and per cup purchases.

Districts 21 and 22 have confirmed to host Spring Assembly. Summer Assembly dates will be discussed today in new business due to the Texas State Convention schedule for the 4th weekend in June 2024.

Finally, I am working on a document that consolidates past assembly locations. This will assist in-coming convention chairs. 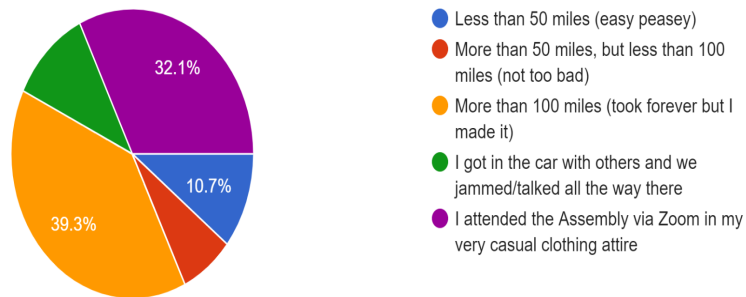
